- Regularly recruit and develop new and potential leaders in efforts to continue growing the Ministry.
- Invest relationally and intentionally within the Rockharbor community, cultivating a high-level of awareness of the overall community & discipleship needs and trends of the church.
- Ensure that Group Leaders are cared for, pastored, appreciated, and resourced via Shepherds, events/trainings, and personal relationships.
- Create Weekly Sermon-Based Curriculum as a Group resource.
- Pray towards, think creatively, and implement other types of curriculum, trainings, and other relevant methods of equipping for Groups & their leaders.
